

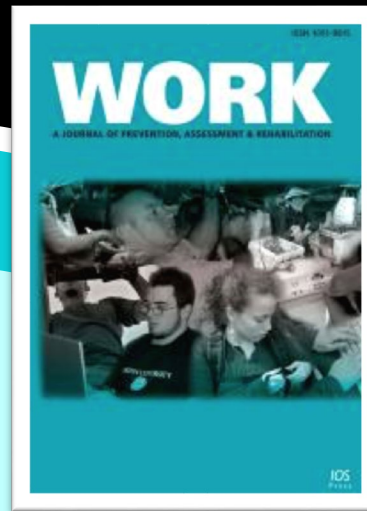
About the Journal

WORK: A Journal of Prevention, Assessment & Rehabilitation (impact factor: 2.3) is an interdisciplinary, international journal, which publishes high quality peer-reviewed manuscripts covering the entire scope of the occupation of work. Work is broadly defined as occupation and includes employment, education, and volunteerism.

The journal's subtitle has been deliberately laid out: The first goal is the prevention of illness, injury, and disability. When this goal is not achievable, the attention focuses on assessment to design client-centered intervention, rehabilitation, treatment, or controls that use scientific evidence to support best practice.

Call for Papers: Special Issue on Immigration, Diversity of the Workforce and Vulnerabilities in OHS

You are invited to submit a manuscript for consideration in a special issue titled, *Immigration, Diversity of the Workforce and Vulnerabilities in OHS*, which follows on from the IDIVOSH conference held in Montreal on 13-14 June 2023. The aim of this special issue is to highlight the latest work on OHS issues among immigrant workers and temporary migrants, and the different forms of vulnerability that can affect them. The intersectional nature of these issues and the social inequalities in health will also be highlighted, as well as certain issues relating to gender, intercultural communication, precarious work and the rehabilitation of ethno-culturally diverse workers who have suffered an occupational injury.
