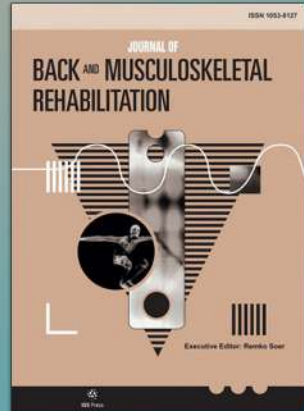
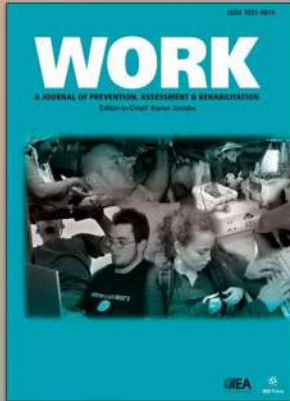

**January 1, 2024:** Reviews provided to authors

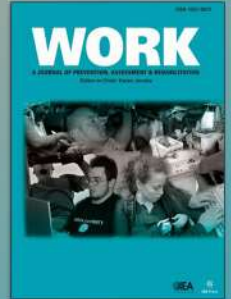
**February 1, 2024:** Final manuscripts due

# About the Journal

WORK: A Journal of Prevention, Assessment & Rehabilitation is an interdisciplinary, international journal, which publishes high quality peer-reviewed manuscripts covering the entire scope of the occupation of work. Work is broadly defined as occupation and includes employment, education, and volunteerism.

The journal's subtitle has been deliberately laid out: The first goal is the prevention of illness, injury, and disability. When this goal is not achievable, the attention focuses on assessment to design client-centered intervention, rehabilitation, treatment, or controls that use scientific evidence to support best practice.



## Special Issue on Work Related Pain

You are invited to submit a manuscript for consideration in a special issue titled, **Work Related Pain**. Work related pain can occur either as a direct result of work or pain that affects work performance.

Topics include but are not limited to:

- Job stress and the prevalence of low back pain
- Environmental factor impacting work related pain
- Impact of conditions such as arthritis on work performance
- Workplace accommodations

Article types welcomed: Original research, Efficacy and effectiveness studies, Systematic reviews, Scoping reviews and Case studies.
